The annual WEI Scholarship Award is offered to deserving high school seniors who best meet the requirements set forth by the Scholarship Committee. Scholarship awards are limited to assistance with tuition, fees, and/or books. Award amounts are at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee.

The Scholarship Committee will review and score all submitted applications and may even choose to interview a selection of applicants. The scholarship recipients will be notified no later than July 31, 2025.

Guidelines for the WEI Sponsored Scholarship Program

Scholarships are open to graduating high school seniors who currently attend a high school in Solano County, graduate in 2025, **and** meet the following requirements:

Must have acquired acceptance to and be enrolled as a full-time student in an accredited post-high school education program, which may include a college, university, business, technical, or trade school for the Fall semester of 2025.

Immediate family members of WEI Board members and WEI volunteers are not eligible.

Student applicants should note any special financial needs on their application form.

Completed applications and all supporting documents *must* be postmarked or received by April 20, 2025, at 5:00 PM, PST.

Please advise your high school registrar of this deadline for submission of official (sealed) transcripts and other supporting documentation as soon as possible.

3. If handwritten, applications must be legible or may be disqualified. The application can be downloaded and printed at www.weihumanitarian.org. Please include additional pages if necessary to answer all questions completely.
4. Applications must include the following:
 - Completed Application form and all supporting documents including an essay.
 - Two character reference letters from unrelated people. (i.e., pastor, teacher, etc.)
 - A copy of your most recent high school official transcript. It must be sealed.
5. Applications and all supporting documents **must** be postmarked or received by: **April 20, 2025, no later than 5:00 PM, PST.**
6. Successful applicants will be notified on or before May 1, 2025.
7. Scholarship monies will be distributed during the Fall 2025 semester once the Registrar’s Official Proof of Enrollment letter is received from the scholarship awardee. **This must be mailed to the address shown on page one as soon as possible and no later than November 15, 2025, or the scholarship award will be forfeited.**
